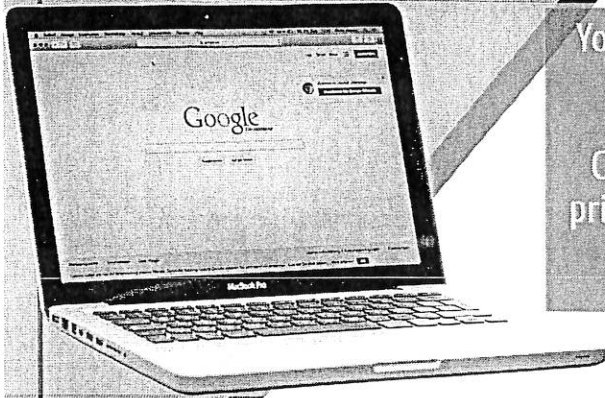
What is Google Classroom?

Think of Google Classroom (GC)
as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use GC to share assignments,
homework, newsletters, and much more
with students AND parents!



Getting Started

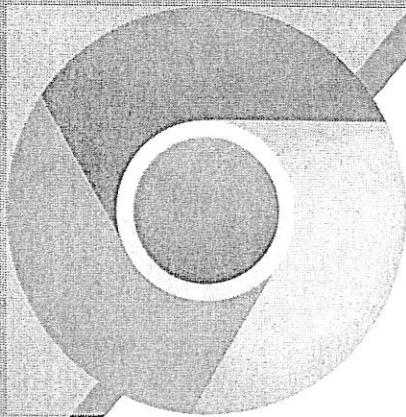


Your child was provided with a secure login and password that is unique to them.

Check with his/her teacher to obtain this private information OR ask them to add you as a parent via email! *

* We will be having students join our Google Classroom in person. Parents will be invited by email to join as guardians.

1 Click on the Google Chrome browser icon.

2 Type www.google.com into your web address bar.



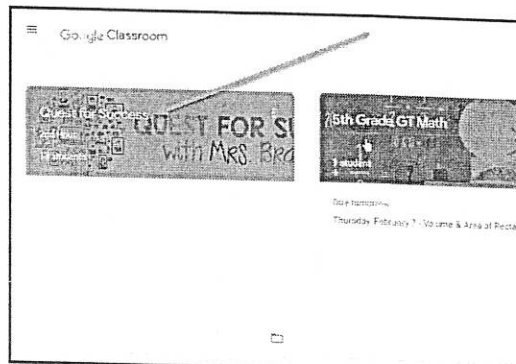

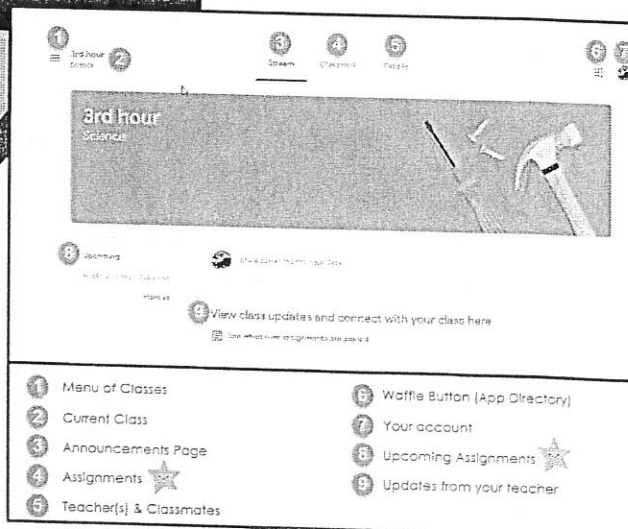
